HKT x WESTK POPFEST presents Hong Kong's largest outdoor dance party "Submerged Paradise" from 1 to 3 November Featuring mega light installation *Submergence*

Dance Director Shing Mak, alongside DJ Heartgrey, will join with Stanley Yau @ MIRROR and Fatboy @ ERROR, to stage performances against the impressive backdrop. Admission is free.



(30 October 2024, Hong Kong) The West Kowloon Cultural District Authority (the Authority or WKCDA) and HKT joined together to proudly present Hong Kong's flagship pop music festival "HKT x WESTK POPFEST" (POPFEST), which will take place between 31 October and 3 November 2024. With HKT as title sponsor and the WKCDA Performing Arts Division as curator and producer, the second edition of POPFEST will present *Submergence*, a large-scale immersive art installation by UK artistic team Squidsoup at Harbourside Lawn East, setting the backdrop for HKT x WESTK POPFEST: "Submerged Paradise" – Harbourside Installation Dance ("Submerged Paradise"), the city's largest-ever outdoor music and dance party.

"Submerged Paradise" will take place for three consecutive nights between 1 and 3 November 2024. The installation will light up at 6pm and open to the public until 11pm. The Dance Party will officially commence at 8pm, while flash mob tricycle piano busking and dance performances will take place on Saturday and Sunday afternoons. Admission for the installation and dance programmes is free, members of the public are welcome to join the dance and music celebration against the breathtaking view of the Victoria Harbour.

Star-studded lineup of dancers brings cross-disciplinary collaborations that blend pop music, dance and visual arts

Meticulously curated by renowned Hong Kong choreographer Shing Mak, featuring music by award-winning beatboxer DJ Heartgrey, the outdoor music and dance party "Submerged Paradise" will present a dizzying array of dance genres, including city pop, urban, jazz funk, hip hop, tap dance, Latin dance and contemporary ballet alongside street dance battles. Xiqu elements will be incorporated while resident dancers from the Hong Kong Dance Company will perform contemporary





Chinese dance, inviting different artists to perform each night, while taking the festival experience to new heights.

Do not miss the artist line-up in the city's largest dance party. In his performance "Drunk in Love", **Stanley Yau** from MIRROR will channel a surreal unrequited love for a contemporary ballerina inside the dazzling lights. **Fatboy** from ERROR has been obsessed with dancing since his childhood. He will take the stage by "STORM" with a performance in a rainfall imagery inside of the installation, paying tributes to two Asian superstars Aaron Kwok and Rain (Jung Ji-hoon).

Lyman Heung, former New York-based Broadway musical actor and Champion of *King Maker V*, will be sharing his love for musical, swing jazz and big band music in 60s in a Broadway style ballroom created by the lights in the installation with his performance "Swing & Beat". **KC** and **Tsoul** will present "Life in Rehearsal," offering a glimpse into how they find their shared passion in dancing along the monotonous work life. The audience will also witness a jaw-dropping performance that blends hiphop, popping and krump with bone-breaking and flexing street dance by **Ben Chiu**. His freestyle showdown, aptly named "Battle with Ben Chiu", promises to bring the dance realm to life with his dance battle with renowned dancers Popping Lok and Ocean. Dance Director Shing Mak will make his surprise appearance on stage, together dancing with the dance crew, to awaken the audience to the memories of "Cantopop 80-90s".

The audience can wander freely among the dazzling, colourful strands of light and experience the energetic festival vibe. The schedule is as follows:

HKT x WESTK POPFEST: Popnorama – the major highlight of POPFEST – will take over the iconic outdoor stage Wonderland at WestK on 2 and 3 November 2024, featuring 10 top-notch pop acts from Hong Kong and around the world. HKT x WESTK POPFEST: Celestial Unboxed takes place at The Box at Freespace on 2 and 3 November 2024, featuring local independent music producer J1M3 – a close collaborator with various popular singers and bands – as music director together with four local singers each with a distinct personal style. Embracing the explorative spirit of Freespace, the concert's concept draws on the four astrological elements, Fire, Earth, Water and Wind, to present pop music works and arrangements with contrasting lighting and video that embody the passionate intensity of fire, the stability and solidity of the earth, the fluidity and sensitivity of water, and the ever-changing nature of wind.
